Representative Terry Morrow Receives Transportation Advocate Award

Representative Terry Morrow was honored for his work as a strong champion of transportation improvements in the region by the Minnesota Transportation Alliance. Representative Morrow was presented with the 2010 Legislator Advocate Award by Julie Anderson, Vice President of Mathiowetz Construction and President of the Minnesota Transportation Alliance.

Since his election to the Minnesota House of Representatives in 2006, Representative Morrow has been a champion for transportation improvements. He has worked closely with local government officials and members of communities in his district to advocate for needed safety improvements. As a member of the House Transportation Committee, Rep. Morrow has worked to provide additional funding for projects in Greater Minnesota. The Alliance recognized his work during the 2010 Legislative Session to accelerate and expand the sale of trunk highway bonds to speed up the completion of needed highway work.
